Weaponizing Religion

- October 2018: Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew I annulled an edict from 1686 that transferred the Kyiv Metropolinate from Constantinople to the Moscow Patriarchate
- December 2018: Ukrainian Orthodox Church-Kyiv Patriarchate, Ukrainian Autocephalous Orthodox Church, and two bishops from the Ukrainian Orthodox Church-Moscow Patriarchate united to form the Orthodox Church of Ukraine
- January 2019: Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople granted a tomos of autocephaly, giving canonical recognition to the Orthodox Church of Ukraine
- For the first time in over 300 years, religious life in Ukraine was not directed from Moscow







Percentage of Just Orthodox among Orthodox over Time


