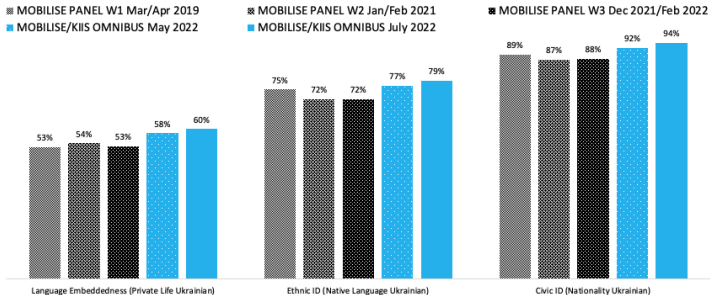

Percentage Point Change in Residents' Declaration of Ukrainian Nationality in Oblast 1989-2001 Census

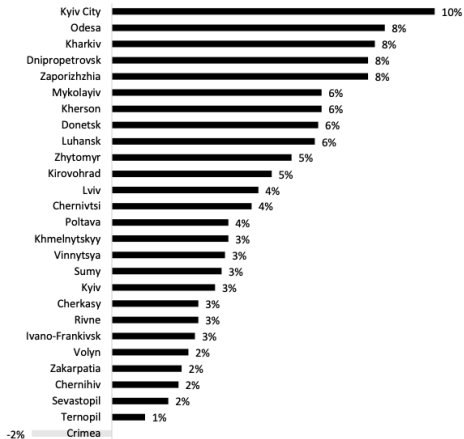
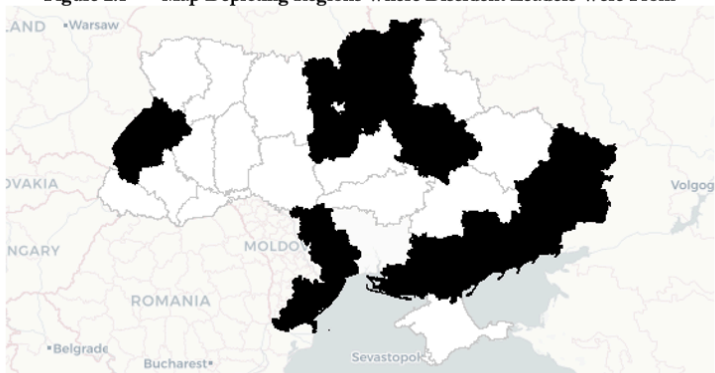


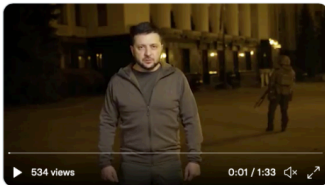
Figure 2.1 Map Depicting Regions Where Dissident Leaders Were From

Figure 7.9 Word Frequency Analysis of Ze's Speeches 2022 Pre-February 24 Ze's Speeches 2022 Post-February 24



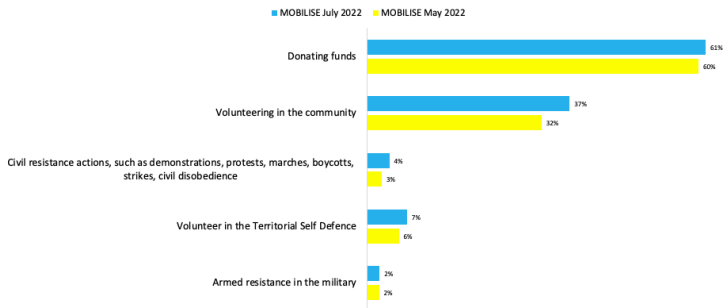

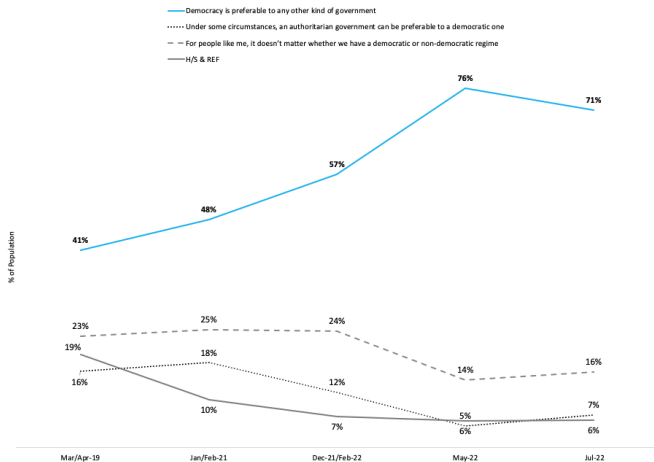

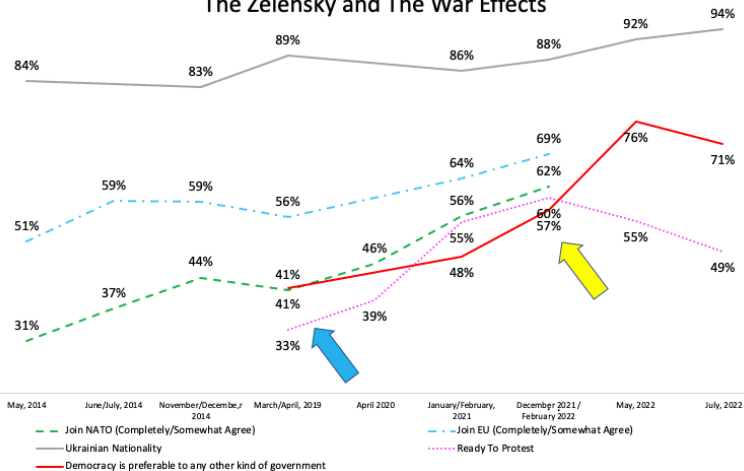
